In that year the total cost of the new Club-house was ascertained to be 1967, 1s. 9d. , of which sum 500 had been borrowed on the security of the property, the remainder having been met by the available funds of the Club. Thus, appropriately enough, almost exactly a hundred years to the very month after the admirers of the antient and healthfull exercise of the Golf had drafted the first rules, we find the association possessed of a local habitation and a name--to wit, a comfortable Club-house just completed, and every indication of increasing prosperity.
