On the 20th of June 1860, Mr. Douglas wrote a letter accepting the nomination of the Baltimore Convention, and cordially endorsing the platform upon which it was made. The additional resolution, of which he speaks in the following extract from his letter of acceptance, is the resolution we have just quoted. Mr. Douglas says: Upon careful examination of the platform of principles adopted at Charleston and re-affirmed at Baltimore, with an additional resolution which...
