All male Spaniards over twenty-five years of age who are in the full enjoyment of their civil rights and are residents of a municipality in which they have resided at least two years, are electors in the islands of Cuba and Porto Rico. Noncommissioned officers and privates of the navy or army can not cast votes while they are serving in the ranks. The same suspension is established with regard to those who are in similar circumstances in other corps or armed institutions under the orders of the State, province, or municipality. Art. 2. The following can not be electors: 1. Those who have been sentenced by a final sentence to perpetual loss of political rights and disqualification for public offices, notwithstanding that they have been pardoned, unless they have previously obtained their personal rehabilitation by means of a law. 2. Those who, by a final sentence, have been condemned to a corporeal penalty, if they...
